

Maidenhead Civic Society first launched Maidenhead and Me in 2014 to encourage public appreciation of the place we call home.

Five years on, our aim is the same and we're sure that participating artists and photographers will enjoy rising to the challenge of our theme this year – People Make It What It Is.

Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors, there are splendid prizes on offer in both Art and Photography sections, with three age categories in each.

An exhibition of all the entries will open in the Nicholsons Centre after the prize giving on Saturday, October 20. The entry rules are listed below. Please read them carefully.

How To Enter:

- Maidenhead and Me is open to Art and Photographic entries in three categories: Adult, Senior (11 years to 18 years) and Junior (10 years and under).
- Entrants will portray the theme of 'People make it what it is' in the medium of their choice.
- Finished artwork should be no smaller than 30cm x 30cm (12in x 12in) and no larger than 76cm x 76cm (30in x 30in), excluding any mount or frame. Photographs should be a minimum image size of 240mm x 150mm (ie A4 with border). Entries must be ready to hang with picture wire/cord and eyelets.
- No limit on number of entries. However, Seniors and Juniors may not enter other categories (proof of age may be required).
- An entry form must be completed and attached to each submitted entry, with the appropriate fee per entry Adult £2.50, Senior £1.00, Junior 50p.
- Completed work should be delivered to the Maidenhead and Me unit in the Nicholsons Centre between Friday, October 12 and Sunday, October 14. Work can be submitted at other times by arrangement.
- Entries will be judged by representatives of the sponsors. Their decision is final.

The Prizes:

Art and Photography sections both have three categories, with three prizes to be won in each:

■ Adult: 1st £200, 2nd £100, 3rd £50
 ■ Senior (11-18yrs): 1st £50, 2nd £20, 3rd £10
 ■ Junior (10yrs and under): 1st £20, 2nd £10, 3rd £5
